Begins at 5 p.m. each Sunday. Each adult Sunday School class is assigned one Sunday a month. Here is our October schedule:

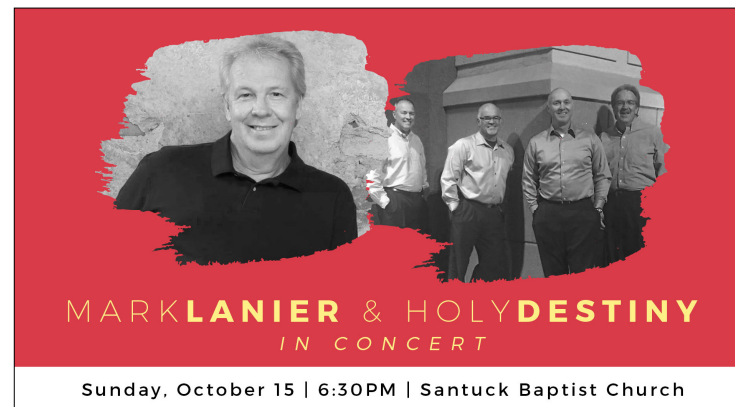
