I. The Plot to Kill Paul (vv. 1-5)

- II. We battle against the <u>flesh</u> and the <u>world</u> (vv. 7-10).
 - a. The Flesh
 - Romans 7:18 "nothing good in our flesh"
 - Romans 13:14 "make no provision for the flesh"
 - Galatians 5:17 "the desires of the flesh are *against* (lit. "to lie opposite to") the Spirit"
 - Philippians 3:3 "put no confidence in the flesh"
 - b. The World
 - 1 John 3:13 "the world hates you (believers)"
 - James 4:4 "friendship with the world is enmity (hatred) with God"
 - James 1:27 "keep oneself unstained from the world"
 - Romans 12:2 "do not be conformed to this world"
- III. The <u>Single-mindedness</u> of Paul (vv. 18-22).
 - Acts 9:15
 - Single-mindedness is propelled by:
 - a. God's <u>love</u> (2 Corinthians 5:14).
 - b. My <u>brokenness</u>, His <u>power</u> in and through me (2 Corinthians 4:7).
- IV. Getting on the road to single-mindedness (Warning: this is not a formula!).
 - a. Pray for a <u>vision</u> to see people how Christ sees them (Isaiah 6:1-7).
 - b. Be willing to <u>sacrifice</u>: my obsessions (<u>control</u>), people, and possessions.
 - c. Pray for His power to work in and through you (Ephesians 3:14-21).
 - d. Remember, God's love, my brokenness, His power.

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
