An infant nursery is always available in the Preschool area as well.

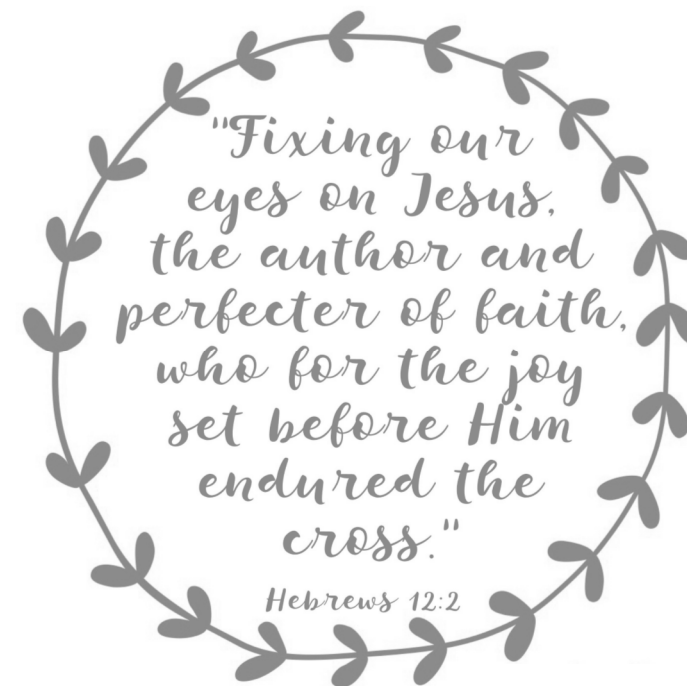
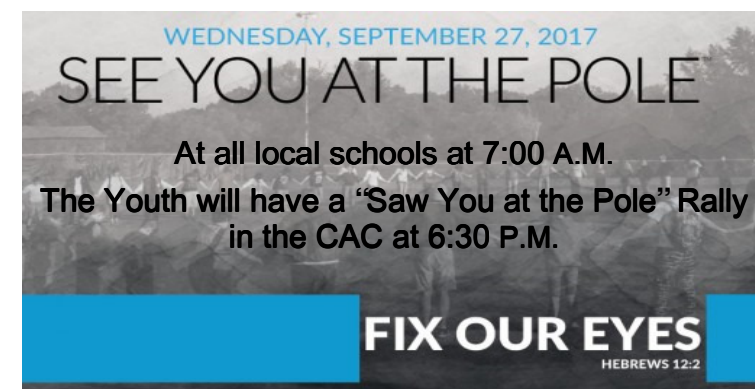
