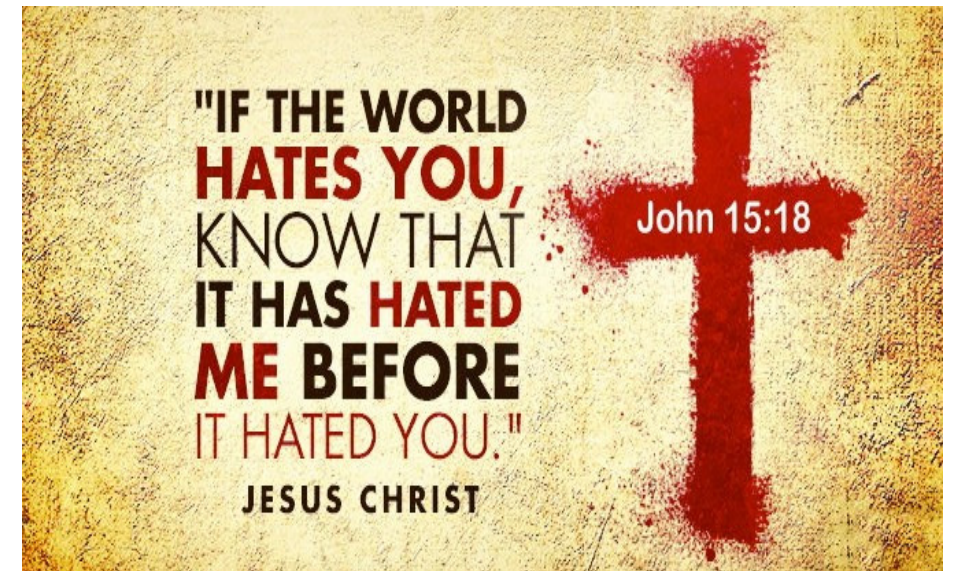

Deacon nominations will begin next Sunday, August 6 and go through August 20. There will be a nomination ballot in your worship guide each week. You may nominate as many men as you would like.


Please prayerfully consider the men you would like to nominate and before you write their names on the ballot please ask them if they would be willing to serve as a deacon.
